

Group Meeting with Andy Lovell

Gloucester County Emergency Response Center

24 September 2007

Regionalization coverage will commence at 0500 29 September 2007

Squad identification 82 (Unit number ending in 5 is first crew, 6 second)

9 Stations 801 to 809.

8 Crews 24/7 (0500- 1800; 1800-0500 plus power shifts 0800-2100)
6 Admin support (4 field supervisors)
128-132 FTE's (50/50 mix of full time/part time)

They will be using EMS Charts for documentation. They plan to have the interface with New World to automatically retrieve the dispatch information into their records.

2008 plans to add GPS/AVL into trucks

Units- 18 total, 10 on street, 8 back up

Alert tones will be from regions that are covered by County EMS (West Deptford area will use 6-9's tones, etc)

Specific questions:

1. Working Fires- they will send as many units as requested. Duty Supervisors will redeploy/add crews to cover areas.
2. Community Events/Sports Events coverage- Truck will be supplied at no cost
3. Training: County will pay all fees for CEU training for employees. They will also open up the training for all EMT's regardless of service platform.
4. Service Platform- Fire Department based EMS units, other Career based units, Independent EMS providers, Private Transport Companies, Police Department Based EMS units.
5. EPI pens- they are willing to share the county's Medical command (Dr Victor A. Heresniak,) and training for all squads to participate in this area of growth.
6. Mutual Aid- Given. Areas that had been receiving mutual aid from towns that will now be covered with County EMS, will continue to receive aid. In the event that the local County trucks that supply your area, your plan will be followed (example if Wenonah, 13-19, needs mutual aid coverage and the County trucks that are based in Mantua are committed on calls, Wenonah's mutual aid plan will be followed.

7. Mutual Aid- Received. In the event that the County EMS units are committed, and before the arrival of a redeployed unit, the county's mutual aid plan is to send the closest ambulance, regardless of service platform to the call.
